
The event has an innovative format based on social networking that offers cultural, tourist and

The International Meeting of Spanish Teaching Centers, ECELE, could not be held without the TURESPAÑA collaboration and its involvement in encouraging and promoting language tourism in Spain.

Since 2008, FEDELE has been collaborating with TURESPAÑA, a public body attached to the **Ministry of Industry, Trade and Tourism** through the **Ministry of Tourism**, responsible for the marketing of Spain as a travel destination in the world, in the promotion of language tourism in Spain, contributing to develop the **promotion and dissemination of the teaching of Spanish as a foreign language**, understanding this educational activity as a prominent tourist resource.

TURESPAÑA is the body responsible for convening Spanish teachers potentially interested in attending ECELE through its network of **33 Tourism Councils abroad**, which represent a strategic asset of the Spanish tourism sector, due to its function as an interface with the sector, professional issuer, opinion prescribers and traveler at origin.

Among other collaborations include:

- Disseminate the existence in Spain of a wide and quality academic offer.
- Promote and disseminate the realization of training and updating programs for knowledge of teachers specialized in teaching Spanish as a foreign language.
- Promote the development of promotion activities and support the idiomatic tourism marketing.
- Improve and expand the attention to the specific needs and demands of the Spanish students as a foreign language in Spain.



OPTION 2. Andalucia Oriental FAM TRIP: Málaga, Granada y Nerja

- Length of each Fam Trip: Two nights, from December 4th to 5th (Departure on December 6th from Málaga airport)
- General Program (global itinerary in Spanish and English)
- Maximum number of participants: 12 agents per Fam Trip (with a minimum of 5 participants to ensure its fulfilment)
- Responsible of the Fam Trip: Executive Secretary of EEA.









- **Length of each Fam Trip**: Two nights, from December 4th to 6th (Departure on December 6th from Málaga airport)
- **General Program** (global itinerary in Spanish and English)
- **Maximum number of participants**: 10 agents per Fam Trip (If one of the Fam Trips does not exceed 5 participants, there will be the possibility of canceling it and move the agents into other Fam Trip)
- **Responsible of the Fam Trip**: Executive Secretary of FEDELE Comunidad Valenciana







Terms and Conditions

1. Registration Dates

The pre-registration period for teachers at the 10th Meeting of Spanish Teaching Centers will remain open from September 10th to October 10th, 2019. The confirmation of the registered will be held on October 15th.

2. Registration Method:

Teachers interested in attending the 10th Meeting of Spanish Teaching Centers should:

To be formally enrolled it will be essential to have filled in the online form, have the mentioned official invitation, and receive the confirmation of participation from FEDELE.

Priority will be given to those teachers who have not participated in previous editions.

The deadline for registration is October 10th. The participation will be confirmed on October 15th.

3. Participation fee:

The participation for teachers is free.

TURESPAÑA and FEDELE are responsible for the expenses of the event, as well as the respective Associations that make up FEDELE. As usual, the contribution of TURESPAÑA through its tourism councils, will be the invitation of teachers, covering their trip to Spain.

4. Includes services:

Participating teachers have the following included services:

- Inclusion in the event catalog
- Certifying documentation and list of participating teachers
- Working lunches (December 2nd and 3rd)
- Dinners (December 1st, 2nd and 3rd)
- Mandatory participation in all the activities proposed in the program

6. Fam Trips

In order to be able to show a wider variety of regions and schools, FEDELE offers the possibility to all federated associations to organize familiarization trips or Fam Trips to their regions.

These Fam Trips take place from the last day of celebration of the main event.

In the announcement of the main event and in all communications FEDELE makes, guests receive information of the Fam Trips that FEDELE offers and can manage their registration in the Fam Trips through their principal registration. transfers and Fam Trips.

The Associations participating in Fam Trips are in charge of teachers and are responsible for:

Teachers who sign up for this event following the explained procedure, accept the following conditions of participation:

- Teachers must participate in all activities that the organization specify in the program which will be sent two weeks in advance to the participating teachers complying with the time and schedules established in the program.
- In case of not attending the programmed activities, lunches or dinners, the person must notify the technical secretary with one hour and a half in advance with a justification and the organization will take the appropriate measures.
- Attendance and compliance with the schedule of the workshop is mandatory.
- It is mandatory to inform the technical secretary of the event any special circumstance that modifies the established schedules of the workshop.
- Teachers at the time of pre-registration and enrollment, accept the current regulations of the Data Protection Law and can be included in videos and photos after the event, as well as its publication in the different FEDELE advertising plans.
